Conference Call Information

You will be emailed a Zoom dial in number and a meeting code with the meeting agenda.

Participating in a Zoom Meeting

- You can use a computer or phone or both.
- The moderator (an SVMA staff member) will need to use a computer at minimum.
- If you are joining by both computer and phone, you need to log into the zoom meeting first, then dial in via phone (a window prompts a person to dial in on the phone)

The address is 202-224 Pacific Avenue, Saskatoon.

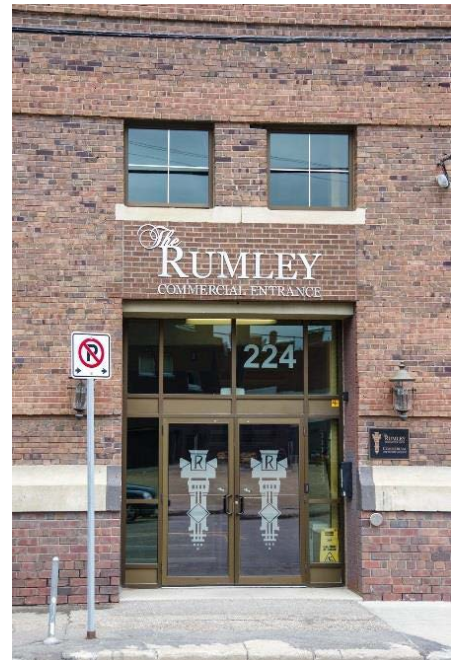

Parking - business hours

*Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm

There are 2 parking lots, the Impark Lot across the street and the small lot right beside the building (the old bus depot parking). Please pay for your own parking and keep the receipt, SVMA can reimburse you.

*if there is no parking in the Impark Lot, you can park on the street at a meter, we usually have loonies available, but please note at street meters, it's a max of 2 hours, and the city monitors it closely! Also, the Midtown Plaza parking lot is ½ block away, keep your receipt and submit it if you use this option.



Parking - evenings/Sundays

If parking after 6pm or on a Sunday, please use the street parking around the Rumley Building. City of Saskatoon meters are **FREE evenings after 6pm and all day Sunday**.

*Note that the Impark lot is a 24-hour pay lot.

Office Access

The Rumley Building is a secured building. The Commercial Entrance doors unlock at ~7:45am and lock at ~7:00pm Monday to Saturday.

To get in after those hours, or on Sunday, you will need to be “buzzed” in by SVMA staff.

On the keypad outside the building hit 202. The office phone will ring, we will answer and let you in. The door won't “Buzz”, you may hear a click, but it will unlock.

Washroom Access

To access the washrooms, you need a “fob”. They are hanging on the door beside the photocopier. The washrooms are just around the corner from our office (a right, a right and a left).
