ORDER OF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

1. Pursuant to section 23(1)(c) of *The Veterinarians Act*, 1987 (the "Act"), Dr. Bath's continued practise shall be subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) Within three months of the date of the Order, Dr. Bath shall prepare a written information piece on the application, correct monitoring and risks of using forced-air warming units suitable for distribution and use by the profession. The information piece will be submitted to the Registrar.
 - (b) Within two months of the date of the Order, Dr. Bath shall complete the online medical records course referenced at <https://www.vetmedteam.com/class.aspx?ci=396> or such similar course as may be determined by the Registrar of the Saskatchewan Veterinary Medical Association (the "SVMA") and shall provide proof of satisfactory completion of that course to the Registrar.
 - (c) Dr. Bath shall be subject to two unannounced inspections of his medical records to occur within 12 months following his completion of the medical records course. The cost of the inspections shall be at the regular hourly rate of SVMA inspectors and shall be borne by Dr. Bath. The inspections will be performed by a practice inspector who is otherwise in Regina on other SVMA business.
 - (d) Failure to complete the written information piece on the use of forced-air warming units and/or the online medical record-keeping course and to provide proof of satisfactory completion as directed; or failure to maintain his medical records as determined in the medical record inspections will result in the immediate suspension of Dr. Bath's member license and his right to practice veterinary medicine in the Province of Saskatchewan; and in the event he is not then licensed, he will be denied the right to membership in the SVMA;
2. Pursuant to section 23(1)(d) of the Act, Dr. Bath shall receive a letter of reprimand.
3. Pursuant to section 23(2)(a)(ii) of the Act, Dr. Bath shall pay the actual costs of the investigation and hearing which shall not exceed \$25,000.00. The costs shall be paid on or

before October 27, 2022. Failing payment, Dr. Bath's license to practise shall be suspended until payment is made pursuant to section 23(2)(b) of the Act. In the event he is not then licensed, he will be denied the right to membership in the SVMA.

4. Further to paragraph 1(b), Dr. Bath shall pay the costs of the inspections within a twelve month period following the satisfactory completion of the record-keeping course. Failing payment, Dr. Bath's license to practise shall be suspended until payment is made pursuant to section 23(2)(b) of the Act. In the event he is not then licensed, he will be denied the right to membership in the SVMA.
